About Carole Barnes, NWS, AWS-DF Carole Barnes has a degree in Art Education from Penn State. She is a member of NWS and a Dolphin member of AWS.

Her work has received many awards in national shows and is in collections such as IBM and SAS. Carole has taught creative water media workshops across the country for 30 years. She was honored by American Artist magazine as acrylic teacher of the year. Her jury experience includes many state exhibits as well as VWS, NWS and AWS multiple times. She has recently moved from Boulder, CO to Williamsburg, VA.

Juror's Statement

My goal as a juror is to select a show that is strong, well balanced, and exciting. It should reflect the diversity of the many fine artists of Virginia. My choices will run from the best of realistic transparent watercolor to abstract and non-objective work in watermedia. I want the best of this variety to be represented. Although composition is important, my goal is to get a feeling, a mood, a sense of time and place from my selections. I want the work to catch my eye and to slow me down. My challenge will be to attempt to see or feel the content through the eyes and heart and soul of each artist.

The goal of this workshop will be to personalize and clarify your work.

This class will include demos, lectures, and individual critiques with lots of paint time. Included in this class will be 5 things.

1. Creative and experimental techniques and how to start a painting.
2. Developing a painting with design elements and principles.
3. Maintaining the joy of painting, breaking blocks, and seeking creativity.
4. How to finish a painting, knowing when you are done and ways to critique your work.
5. Content, intent, passion, and purpose. Ways to extend your workshop experience.

Demos will be acrylic on paper, but all water media can be used.

Artist may paint on surface of your choice.

Strathmore Aquarius paper will be available for sale at the workshop.

A supply list and map will be provided upon acceptance. A wait list will be maintained in case of cancellations.
